Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to welcoming all of the girls to Scoil Mhuire on Tuesday. Here are some notes to help you and your daughter for the first day.

Arrival Times

8.45am - 9.10am - Pupils from 1st to 6th Class arrive and walk straight into their classroom via their allocated door. Please see the map attached that clearly shows the entrance door for each class. Parents will not be permitted to enter past the school gate.

9.30am - Junior and Senior Infants arrival time for Week 1 only. One parent/guardian can walk the child to their classrooms' designated door. Pupils will then enter the classroom with their teacher. From Week 2 arrival time will be 8.45am - 9.10am .

Dismissal Times

1.30pm - Junior Infants (Ms.Brett) and Junior/ Senior Infants Multi-grade class (Ms.McCann) will be collected from the School Yard by one parent/guardian.

Senior Infants (Ms. Behan's Class) will be collected from the School Car Park where they enter in the mornings by one parent/guardian.

2.30pm - 1st Class (Ms.McCallion) will be collected from the School Car Park where they enter in the mornings by one parent/guardian.

2nd Class (Ms.McGuirk) will be collected from the School Yard by one parent/guardian.

2.40pm - ALL 3rd Class Pupils are collected from the School Car Park by one parent/guardian

4th - 6th Class will walk from their classrooms outside the main school gates and meet parents/guardians at a pre-arranged spot. This spot should be discussed with parents and children so they know where to meet you.

We are asking parents to please minimise the time you spend on the school premises. We are operating a 'Drop and Go' and 'Pick up and Go' system only.

What to bring to school?

- Junior and Senior Infants: Please bring a school bag with your lunchbox and a water bottle. You can send in some items/ books from the booklist each day between Tuesday and Thursday so the bags are not too heavy.
- 1st to 6th Class: Please bring a school bag with your lunchbox and a water bottle. Please bring a well stocked pencil case as sharing items is no longer allowed. Please bring English, Irish and Maths books and some copies on Tuesday. The remainder of books and items can be brought in on Wednesday. This is so the school bags will not be too heavy.
- 2nd - 6th Class: During break times each of these classes will have a designated section of the grass to use. We are asking all pupils from 2nd to 6th Class to please bring in spare Wellies/Old runners in a bag to wear for break times if the grass is wet. These will be kept in school and used as needed. Girls can hang this bag on their coat hook.
